Sir,

The Corporation of Madras supply a conservancy cart to the School of Arts, Madras, for the daily removal of the nightsoil accumulating in the school latrine, and levy a charge of Rs. 8-10-6 per mensem therefor - a rate which has been in force since 1910. In his letter No. P.A.Kis. 4-16476 dated 12th November 1915, the Accountant-General states that the sanction of Government is required to incurring this charge, under item (M) Appendix B.B.B.B., Civil Account Code. 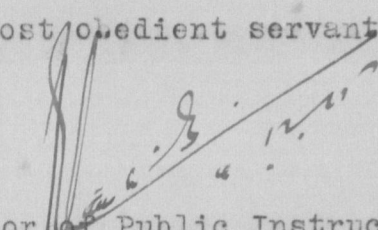

With a view, however to obviating the need for thus seeking and granting formal sanction from month to month, I would suggest for the consideration of Government the desirability of authorising the Superintendent to incur this expenditure without the sanction of Government so long as it does not exceed Rs. 8 - 10 - 6 per mensem subject to the existence of budget provision.

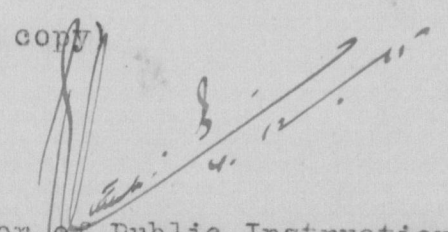

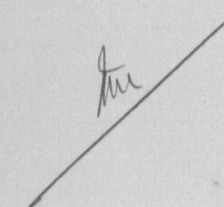

The Corporation of Madras levy a monthly fee of Rs 8.10.6 for the supply of a causeway cart to the School of Arts for the removal of the nightsoil accumulating in the school latrine. The charge being a recurring one the Acct General states that under item (M) appendix B.B.B.B; Civil Account Code ^(Vol I) (page 307) the sanction of Govt is required for the incurring of the expenditure. To avoid formal sanction being given month after month the D.P.D. proposes to allow the Supdt., School of Arts to incur the expenditure so long as it does not exceed Rs 8.10.6 per mensem (the rate in existence since 1910) subject to the existence of budget provision. As the Acct General does not object to the ^{Director's} proposal, it is for consideration whether ~~the Director's proposal~~ ^{it} may be approved. If so the draft order below is for approval. If approved, it may issue with the concurrence of Finance.

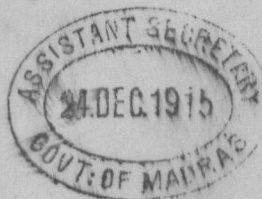
