SIR,

(B) With reference to para 2 of G.O.No.1174-Edl., dated
27th October 1915, I have the honour to submit for the orders of
Government a question regarding the debit of the Railway fare and
Passage money paid in connection with the voyage from India to
England of Miss Myers, to whom a special scholarship of £ 200/a year
has been sanctioned by the Government of India.

2. The scholarship is payable from Provincial Revenues
and the payments made in England will be passed on to India through
the Secretary of State's remittance account for final adjustment
against Provincial Revenues. I would enquire, therefore, whether the
Railway fare and Passage money in question should also be adjusted
as a charge against Provincial Revenues. I make this reference as
the Government Order referred to above is silent on this point.

3. Government of India letter No.694/698, dated 31st August 1907, in which Local Government have been empowered to sanction payment of the travelling expenses of State Scholars from India to England and to adjust the cost as a charge against Imperial Revenues seems to refer only to cases in which the scholarships are paid from Imperial Revenues.

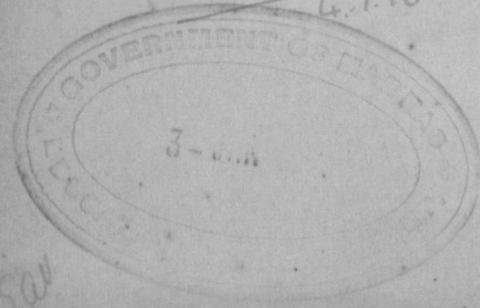
