Read letter from the Collector of Madras, R.O.C. No.177/G1. of 16 dated 12th February 1916.

"I have the honour to submit for favour of Board's sanction an application for temporary exemption from examination rules of one C. Sarabalingam Naidu whom I have appointed to act as Income Tax Accountant on Rs. 50/- in this office in a short privilege leave vacancy. He has studied up to the Matriculation class but has not passed any examinations. He served as Madras agent to the estate of the Maharajah of Vizianagaram for a period of about 6 years and as accountant in the Urban Bank M. & S.M. Railway Company for about 4 months. In these capacities he appears to have acquired a fair knowledge of accounts. I propose to try him as Income Tax Accountant in a short vacancy.

Resolution

M.R.Ry. C. Sarabalingam Naidu will be exempted from the examination rules for a period of two months for employment as an Income Tax Accountant in the Madras Collectorate.
