Resolutions on the Annual Financial Statement.

The Hon'ble Diwan Bahadur A. SUBBARAYALU REDDIYAR Avargal:—

XIV. This Council recommends to His Excellency the Governor in Council that the lump provision made in the Budget under 22—F. Education—Government Schools—special, for opening additional training schools for women, be specifically allotted for opening a Training school at Cuddalore.

Specific provision for the opening of a training school for women at Cuddalore.

The Additional Member has on three previous occasions asked questions at the Legislative Council meetings regarding the desirability of opening a training school for mistresses at Cuddalore. With reference to question No. 212 asked by him at the meeting of the Legislative Council held on the 21st November 1916, the Additional Member was informed that proposals for providing for the training of women teachers at Cuddalore were expected from the Director of Public Instruction.

2. A lump provision of Rs.10,000 has been made in the budget estimate for 1917-18 for the opening of additional training schools for women. The Additional Member now requests that the lump provision may be specifically allotted for the opening of a training school for mistresses at Cuddalore.

3. The proposals referred to in paragraph 1 supra for the opening of a training school for mistresses at Cuddalore with effect from the 1st July 1917 have recently been received from the Director of Public Instruction. The cost involved therein amounts to Rs.7,304 during 1917-18. The proposals have been accepted in this department and the case has been passed on to Financial for acceptance on the 26th February 1917. The Additional Member may perhaps withdraw the resolution if he is informed that the question of opening a training school for mistresses at Cuddalore with effect from the 1st July 1917 is ~~not under consideration~~ actually now before Government and orders thereon will be published shortly - possibly even before the

Legislative Council meets, and if he is assured that Cuddalore will be the first to receive attention ^(in this report). It may not be desirable to earmark the whole of the lump allotment for Cuddalore school alone; with the balance not covered by the estimated cost of this school some advance may be made in connection with the preliminaries of a second school if need be. The object which the Additional Member has in view will be achieved without resorting to the means suggested in the Resolution.

4. Orders are solicited as to who should reply to the resolution at the Council meeting, whether any further information should be collected and whether the attitude of the Government in replying to it should be discussed in the Executive Council.
