Sir,

I have the honour to state that a provincial --
subsidy of Rs. 900/- per annum was sanctioned for the
improvement of the staff of the Chattram Incomplete --
Secondary School, Orattanad. Out of the grant received
for the official years 1915-16, and 1916-17, a sum of --
Rs. 653-14-9 remains unspent . When proposals were
submitted to Government for the revision of the scale of
pay of the teachers a progressive scale of salary was --
adopted and this resulted in an average increase of --
Rs. 76-12-6 per mensem. The said increase was sanc-
tioned in G.O. No. 805/1. Mis., dated 27-4-14 as annual
contribution from the Provincial funds. As the average

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increase adopted in the proposition statement was higher than the expenditure during the first half of the increment period, there has been a considerable unspent balance. The District Board has resolved in its resolution No. 70 dated 15-2-18 to utilise the balance towards the purchase of library books and science-- and geographical equipment for the use of the school in accordance with the recommendation of the Inspector of Schools, VI Circle, Tanjore. I request that the Government may be pleased to approve of the proposal of the District Board. Copy of the District Board's resolution on the subject is enclosed.
