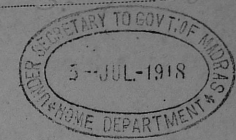

Sir,

I have the honour to request that Government may be pleased to exempt Mr. A. K. Menon, oil chemist and soap expert from the operation of the age bar rules as noted in article 51 of the Civil Service Regulations.

2. Mr. Menon joined service under me in the Fisheries Department in December 1913 and was confirmed in service in the Industries Department as oil chemist and soap expert in November 1917.

3. Mr. Menon at the time of joining the Fisheries Department was 27 years of age and is now 32.

4. He could not join the Government service at the

the prescribed age of 25 since after graduating in chemistry, he was awarded a Government of India Scholarship and had to proceed to England to prosecute his studies on the chemistry of oils and fats and soap making, for which purpose he stayed for about 4 years in England.

5. Having been trained abroad his case may be kindly regarded in the same way as that of other experts in the Industries Department.

Subject. Exemption of H. K. K.

Menon, Oil chemist & soap expert, from the provisions of Art. 51 of the C.S.A.

Art. 51 of the C.S.A. states that a person whose age exceeds 25 years may not ordinarily be admitted into the service of the State without the sanction of the Head of the Dept. In the present case Mr. A. K. Menon has been appointed oil chemist & soap expert by the Govt. That appointment ^{apparently} carries with it the exemption of Mr. Menon from the provisions of Art. 51 of the C.S.A. and it does not appear that a separate order to this effect is necessary. As, however, Sir Frederick Nicholson specifically raises the point the A.G. may be consulted as to whether any order is necessary.

I agree that it is not
 reasonably supposed that an order
 appointing him in view of a post at
 3 years of age would be the
 equivalent of a specific
 exemption from the age bar.
 Will the A.G. please advise as
 to whether an explicit order is
 now necessary?
