With reference to the correspondence ending with G.O.No. 6 dated 3rd January 1918, I have the honor to state that in the deed of conveyance prepared and executed in connection with the acquisition of lands for the S.P.C. Mission at Nandyal, a mistake has occurred with regard to the denotation of the sub-division in S.No. 674. At the time of the submission of the draft declaration the subdivision was denoted as 674/A but it was altered into 674/1 in accordance with the district practice when the subdivision records were finally --- scrutinised by the Land Records Tahsildar. As the --

deed was executed and registered at Madras, the mistake was not noticed by the Registrar of Madras but the Registrar of Cuddapah brought to the notice of the former that the land conveyed was denoted as S.No. 674/1 and not as 674/A. The Registrar of -- Madras thereupon advised the Mission to have the mistake corrected by a rectification deed. On the application of the Mission, a rectification deed has been prepared and submitted herewith for favour of your signature. After the deed has been signed by you, it may be sent to the Reverend Canon G.H.Smith, Secretary M.D.C., S.P.G., Royapettah for signature.

This Indenture made the 16th day of August one thousand nine hundred and eighteen B e t w e e n THE RIGHT HONOURABLE THE SECRETARY OF STATE FOR INDIA IN COUNCIL(hereinafter called "The Vendor") of the one part and the SOCIETY FOR THE PROPAGATION OF THE GOSPEL IN FOREIGN PARTS incorporated by Royal Charter of King William the third of England and having its head office at No. 15 Tufton Street, Westminster, England (hereinafter called "the Purchaser") of the other part.

W H E R E A S by an indenture dated the 3rd January 1918 and registered as No. 237 of 1918 Book 1 Volume 635 pages 274 to 277 of the office of the Registrar Madras-Chingleput District, the land ^{and} premises hereinafter particularly described were intended to be conveyed by the Vendor to the purchaser.

WHEREAS in the conveyance dated the 3rd day of January 1918 in the schedule thereto mistakes have been made with regard to the survey sub-division numbers of the land and premises conveyed and of the land forming the Northern and Southern boundary of the said land and premises.

AND WHEREAS in order to give good title to the Purchaser to the land and premises which formed the actual subject matter of the contract between them, it is necessary that the mistakes made in the indenture of sale dated 3rd January 1918 should be rectified by another document.

AND WHEREAS it has been agreed between the Vendor and Purchaser that such a rectification document should be executed and registered.

NOW THIS INDENTURE WITNESSES that in pursuance of the said agreement, the following alterations be made in the Schedule attached to the said indenture dated 3rd January 1918 Viz.,
