In their order No. 1105 Home (Education) dated 29th August 1917 Government approved among other the proposal to grant an allowance of Rs10 per mensem for providing instruction in Drawing and Drill to the students of the temporary secondary training section attached to the Ceded Districts college, Anantapur. The Principal reports that as he was not able to procure the services of instructors for both the subjects for the sanctioned rate of allowance viz. Rs10 per mensem he had to employ the Drawing and Gymnastic instructors of the local Municipal High school on a remuneration of Rs10 per mensem for each instructor

2. The extra charge can be met from the budget provision for the school as it is reported that one of the posts of peon on Rs8 in it has not been filled up.

In the circumstances explained by the D.P.S., the Govt sanctioned the ~~proposed~~ grant, with effect from the 20th August 1977, of an allowance of Rs 10 per mensem to the drawing master of the Municipal High School, Anantapur, for giving instruction in drawing to the students of the temporary secondary training class attached to the Ceded District College, Anantapur.

on behalf of certain educational officers employed in the Agency tracts in G.O.No. 1654, dated 22nd December 1917. The Government Agent reports that when submitting the original proposals sanctioned in this G.O. there was no idea of opening a training class in Bhadrachalam and that consequently the post of teacher in charge of the training class was not included therein. He now recommends that an allowance of Rs.8 per mensem be sanctioned on behalf of this teacher also with retrospective effect. The Inspector supports the Agent's recommendation on the ground that it will not be possible to obtain in the Agency the services of a qualified Secondary grade teacher for a salary of Rs.40/- per mensem. As there is no reason why this teacher should not be granted a special allowance seeing that he is serving in the Agency, I have the honour to request that Government will be pleased to sanction a local allowance of Rs.8 per mensem on behalf of the teacher with effect from 1st March 1918.

2. The extra expenditure of Rs.96 during the current year can be met from the savings likely to accrue in the provision made for Secondary schools for boys in the Civil Budget estimate for 1918-19.

In their order No. 960 Home (Education) dated 20th July 1917, the Government while approving the proposal to open as a temporary measure an elementary training class in the Government Secondary school, Bhadrachalam, sanctioned the employment of a qualified secondary grade teacher on Rs. 40 per mensem for the class. Accordingly on the recommendation of the Inspector of Schools, 1st Circle, the Government Agent Godavari appointed to the post J. Venkata Rao, acting second Assistant of the Government Secondary school, Bhadrachalam. It is stated that J. Venkata Rao has been a loser by the transfer as in his present post he is not entitled to the local allowance sanctioned
