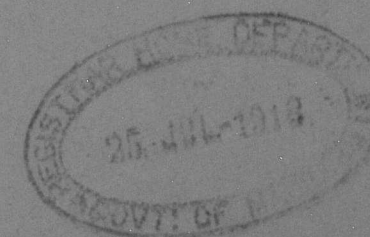

• The Hon'ble YAQUB HASAN SAHIB Bahadur:—"Will the Government be pleased to get that information for me? They are in a better position than anybody else."

The Hon'ble Sir ALEXANDER CARDEW:—"I am not quite sure that any useful purpose will be served by getting the information. What does the Honourable Member want the information for? If he will communicate with me what he wants it for, I will consider whether it is possible or whether it is worth while to call for it."

120 Q.—Will the Government be pleased to lay on the table a descriptive list of Muhammadan charitable endowments under the management and control of the Government, local boards and municipalities? Muhammadan charitable endowments.

120 A.—The Honourable Member's attention is drawn to G.O. No. 2505, Revenue, dated 2nd July 1918, which has been placed on the Editors' table. No further information is at present available.

121 Q.—Will the Government be pleased to state if they have recently received a memorial from the Muhammadans of Nellore praying for the conversion of the first-grade municipal elementary school for Muhammadans into an incomplete secondary school? Will the Government be pleased to direct the Municipality of Nellore to accede to this request and, if necessary, to subsidize the said municipality for this purpose as a part of the scheme lately inaugurated for raising some of the municipal and local board elementary schools to the status of secondary schools? Converting the Municipal Elementary School, Nellore, into a secondary school.

The Hon'ble YAQUB HASAN SAHIB Bahadur:—"Will the Government be pleased to get the information applied for in question No. 122 from the various colleges?"

The Hon'ble Mr. J. H. STONE:—"I would suggest that the Honourable Member should ask the University for the information. The University has a machinery for replying to questions on University matters. It is not a matter with which I am particularly concerned. The information can be got from the University."

The Hon'ble YAQUB HASAN SAHIB Bahadur:—"It refers to the number of students admitted into the various colleges."

The Hon'ble Mr. J. H. STONE:—"The colleges are under the University. The University assumes responsibility over the colleges. The University will have in its office a record of the admissions into the colleges. I have not got any such record."

The Hon'ble YAQUB HASAN SAHIB Bahadur:—"Will the Government be pleased to call for the information from the University?"

His Excellency the PRESIDENT:—"If the Honourable Member wishes to have any further information, he may put a further question later on."

123 Q.—(a) Will the Government be pleased to state the number of Mussalmans in the Judicial service holding (1) the acting and (2) permanent appointments of District Munsifs, (3) the acting and (4) permanent appointments of Sub-Judges, the total number of each of these appointments and the proportion the number of Mussalman incumbents bears to the total number in each?
