With reference to your endorsement No.3074-1 dated the

8th April 1918 Communicating G.O.No.429 Home (Education) dated the 30th March 1918, sanctioning the payment of the halting allowance claimed by Mr. P.K.R. 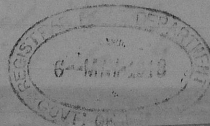

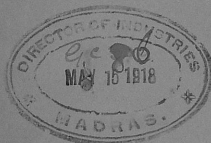
