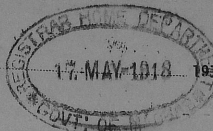

Sir,

The Principal, Government College, Mangalore, reports
that the new rules and regulations about the vernaculars
passed by the Secondary school-leaving certificate Board
and the announcement by the University that students taking
vernacular as an optional will have translation in their
second paper in the Intermediate examination of 1918 and
onwards have had the effect of increasing the already heavy
work of the Sanskrit and Kanarese pandits. It is stated
that the Kanarese pandit, who besides having to correct
74 compositions note-books, has regular class work for 23
periods a week, is at present assisted by the Sanskrit
Pandit and one of the regular members of the staff, who

have to devote to Kanarese work two and five periods a week, respectively. With a view to relieve these officers of such extra-
neous work and to reduce the disproportionately heavy work that
the Kanarese pandit has to do, the Principal, recommends the em-
ployment of an Assistant pandit on Rs.30-1-40 per mensem. I con-
sider the Principal's proposal to be reasonable and worth a trial
for at least a year in the first instance; and I accordingly
commend it for the sanction of Government with effect from 17-6-18
the date of the re-opening of the College after the summer vacation
of the current year. The pay of the post may be fixed at Rs.30 per
mensem during the tentative period. On receipt of the final edi-
tion of the Civil Budget, I shall submit a re-appropriation statement
to meet the cost amounting to nearly Rs.255 during the current year.

2. There are at present in the college a Sanskrit and a
Kanarese pandit on Rs.40-2/2-50 each and a temporary Malayalam pan-
dit on Rs.30 per mensem.

3. A statement showing the number of students who took up
Sanskrit and Kanarese in the college and High school classes during
the year 1917-18 is submitted herewith for the information of Go-
vernment.

3. There is no audit objection to the proposal being sanctioned by Government.

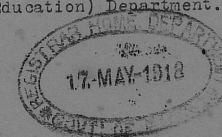
4. The reappropriation of funds promised should be made before any extra expenditure is incurred.

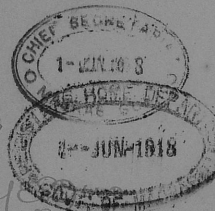
Subject. - Temporary employment of an additional
Kannese pandit for one year in the Govt.
College, Mangalore.

(E) Attention is solicited to the Statement (on pages 3 and 4 of G.O. no. 817 Vol. of 17.12.08) showing the distribution of work that was made in the College on the introduction of the new University Regulation 1905. According to this Statement the total number of periods per week for instruction in Kannese and Sanskrit was 24 and 22 respectively. In the actual distribution of work, however, the Kannese pandit was given 21 periods' work, & the Sanskrit pandit 20 periods' work (including 3 Kannese composition classes and excluding five Sanskrit translation classes). The Sanskrit Translation Classes (5 periods) were assigned to the First Assistant. It is now reported that ~~the~~ owing to certain changes referred to in the current letter the work of the pandit has increased and that the Kannese pandit has regular class work for 23 periods ^{a week}, besides the correction of 74 composition note books and is at present assisted by the Sanskrit pandit (4 periods) and one of the regular members of staff (for five periods a week). The Director not furnished any particulars about the ~~previous~~ work now performed by the Sanskrit

and the regular member of the staff referred
to above. Apparently their work is also heavy
at present, even without taking into account
the help rendered by them to the Kanarese Pandit.
If so, the need for assistance seems to be established.
A Malayalam Pandit has been temporarily
employed with effect from 1st July 1917 and
~~after~~ presumably he does not ~~know~~ ~~about~~ ~~affairs~~
possess sufficient knowledge of Sanskrit or Kanarese
to be able to help either the Kanarese or Sanskrit
sections. It is therefore submitted that the proposal
to employ temporarily for a period of one year
an additional Pandit on Rs 30 per mensem (the
minimum pay of Pandits) may be approved. A
draft order is submitted, ~~for approval~~ it may be
sent to Financial for acceptance.
