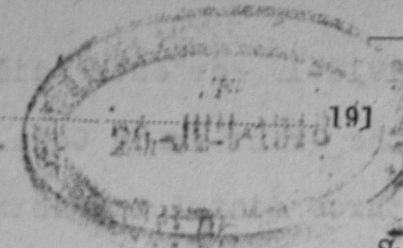

Sir,

I have the honour to request that Government will be pleased to exempt from the operation of ~~the~~ Article ~~1056~~ 1056 of the Civil Service Regulations the marginally noted clerks in the Office of the Assistant Inspector of Schools, Kistna District and in the Offices of the Sub-Assistant Inspectors of Schools in the Second Circle and permit them to draw daily allowance for all the days -- spent by them outside their headquarters in January last. These clerks accompanied their officers for the conference held last January for the assignment of teaching grants to elementary schools for 17-18 and for the admission of

schools to aid during 1918-19 for each district in accordance with rule 18 of the Grant-in-aid Code. The Conference held in each of the three districts, Kistna, Guntur and Nellore in January last has been unduly long and I have since issued instructions that they should in future finish their sittings much sooner. The Inspector of Schools, I Circle, who was asked to furnish the necessary particulars as required under para 8 (III) to article 1056 in the Madras supplement to the Civil Service Regulations has not reported the amount of additional expenditure incurred by each clerk; but as the daily allowance of four annas claimed is hardly sufficient for their subsistence it is certain that the clerks would have actually incurred an expenditure in excess of this amount.

2. The Conference for the Kistna district was held at Bezwa. Although the transfer of the headquarters of the office of the Assistant Inspector of Schools, Kistna district, from Masulipatam to Bezwa was approved in G.O.No.795 Home (Education) dated 15-6-17 it was found possible to give effect to the transfer only from 1-2-18 by renting a private building as the Government building in which the Office was proposed to be held was reported to be required by the Public Works Department.

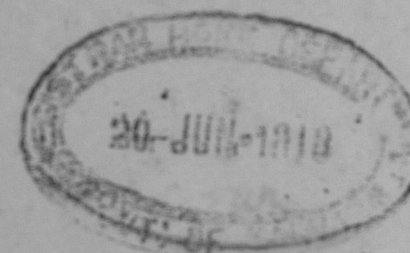
