Sir,

I have the honour to request that Government will be pleased to exempt from the minimum general educational qualification laid down in the Public Service Notification, the following candidates whom I propose to appoint as probationary Sub Inspectors and post to the Vellore school for training during the session commencing from June 1919:-

- (1) Abdur Rahiman
- (2) Muhammad Nurulla.

2. The first named candidate was nominated by the North Arcot district Committee in 1917. He is the son of a

retired Subadar Major and is known to and approved of by the Deputy Inspector-General of Police Mr. Mainwaring. The second candidate appeared before the Nellore district Committee last year, but was rejected as he was not qualified. He belongs to a respectable Muhammadan family, being the son of a retired first class Inspector of Police, and the brother of Khan Sahib Muhammad Abdul Karim Sahib Farukhi, Deputy Superintendent of Police, Railways and C.I.D.

3. There is at present a serious shortage of Sub Inspectors of whom the necessary number for certain Telugu Sub Inspectors has been absolutely unprocurable for some time past. I consider that the above named candidates will be suitable.
