The candidate joined the District Police Office, South Kanara, as acting typist in 1914 and continued to act in that capacity on and off for three years. She was confirmed as a typist in February 1917 and is now drawing Rs.22/- in the grade of Rs.20-1-25. She acted as a clerk in short vacancies and did her work satisfactorily and is fit for appointment as a clerk.

Her prospects as a typist in a District Police Office are very limited. She is an Eurasian and deserves encouragement.

Subject: — Exemption from the examina-
tion rules.

The applicant is a typist on
Rs 20-1-25 and the J.G. recommends
her exemption for appointment to clerical
posts on pay not exceeding Rs 50. It
is not usual to exempt typists from
the provisions of Art. 1 of the Public
Service Notification except in special
circumstances, the reason being that
they can hope to rise to a maximum
of Rs 50 even as typists. It is how-
ever for consideration whether, in view
of the J.G.'s statement that the prospects
of the applicant as a typist in a
Dt. Police Office are very limited and the
fact that she is an Eurasian, the
permanent exemption applied for may
be granted. If so, the maximum
limit of pay up to which she may be
allowed to rise may perhaps be
fixed at Rs 35 instead of at Rs 50
as suggested by the J.G.
