I have the honour to request that Government may be pleased to exempt from the examination rules N. S. Sessa Ayyar, Typist and Shorthand clerk in this Office on Rs.25-1-30 plus Rs.10 Shorthand allowance. The circumstances under which he failed to qualify in the necessary educational tests are set forth by the typist as follows:

"I appeared for the Matriculation Examination in December 1907 and passed in

- A. English,
- B. Second Language--Sanskrit.
- C. Mathematics,

but failed in

D. General subjects,--consisting of Histories of England and India, Geography (world) and Physics and Chemistry.

I again appeared in December 1908. There were two examinations that time on account of a rumour that some papers were out. I passed in the first examination and sat for the second. In the latter, I failed in English passing in all the other subjects (which include the one in which I failed in 1907). Although it is not

worth while trying now I am sure that if marks could be
 obtained it would be seen that I would not have failed
 in each of the years for want of more than 3 or 4 marks
 at the utmost; and again, according to the S. S. L. C.
 examination from 1911 to 1915 candidates who have passed
 in a subject need not appear for that subject again and so
 according to that as I passed in English in 1907 I need
 not appear for that subject again in 1908 and since I
 passed in General subjects (D) in 1908 I should be con-
 sidered to have completed my certificate in 1908. But
 unfortunately that was not to be with the University.

I again remitted money in 1909 and worked hard to get
 a success. But, as ill-luck would have it, some days
 before the date of the examination I fell ill of Typhoid
 fever and was not able to do any work until after 6 months
 or more. Then all the schools were in the middle of a
 term and I could not join any school for want of term days.
 Thus I had to lose a year. Then I joined the Government
 School of Commerce, Calicut. Since then I have passed
 in the following technical subjects all in the Intermediate
 Grades.

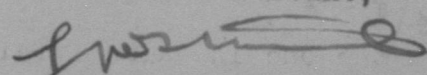

N. S. Sesha Ayyar has worked as Camp Clerk to Mr. Chadwick
 and to myself since 1914. He has thus acquired much
 experience and I can state that he is a smart and efficient
 clerk, well above the average in ability. I therefore
 strongly recommend that he should be exempted from the
 examination rules so that he may become eligible for
 promotion to clerical posts more suited to his abilities.

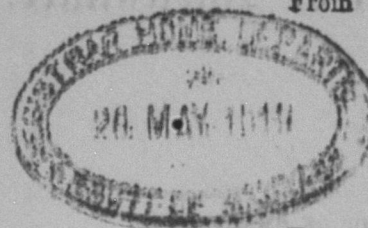

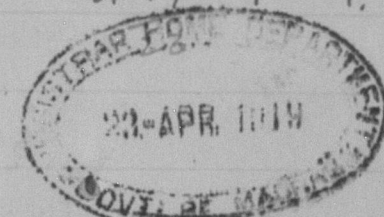

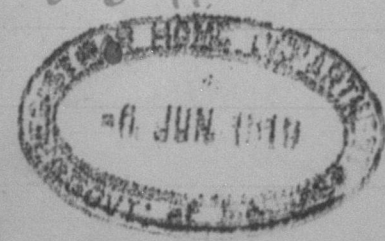
