Mr. Jagadisa Ayyar, the Manager of Archaeological Department, has applied to me for the grant of 27 photographic prints free of cost, to serve as illustrations for his contributions on "South Indian Shrines" which are now appearing in the columns of the illustrated edition of the Madras Times and which he intends publishing eventually in a book form for the benefit of the reading public.
