In returning herewith your endorsement No. 174 T.P. dated 2nd June 1919 on the petition of S. Kalyanasundaram Ayyar, Temporary Clerk of this division, I have the honour to forward herewith an application for exemption from the examination rules and to state as follows:--

2. As already stated in my letter Nos. 1030 dated 5th April 1919 and 1150 dated 16th April 1919, this clerk was entertained in the Department from 11th June 1915 and he has been continuously in service from 8th July 1915 except with a break of 3 days from 1st to 3rd May 1916. This short break also was due to a reduction of temporary establishment in the circle. He is up to the average, writes a neat hand, and has picked up sufficient knowledge as to make himself useful in the department. He has also put in a service of more than 2 years prior to 6th August 1917 as required in G.O. No. 991 Home (Educational) dated 29th July 1918. But if a continuous service of 2 years is required, there is the above break of an insignificant period of 3 days, which might for all practical purposes well be overlooked.

3. I would therefore request you to be good enough to obtain permanent exemption from the examination rules, condoning the above break of 3 days.
