I most respectfully beg to bring the following few
lines for your honour's kind perusal, and favourable
disposal.

2. I was first entertained in the Public Works Department,
as temporary clerk in the year 1895. Having been confirmed as
Lock Superintendent on Rs.10/- with effect from 1-8-98,

I was continued as temporary clerk, up to 11-7-08 F.N.,
when I was confirmed as clerk, V class 1 grade. I have
thus put in a service of 23 years, of which 20 years
thus pensionable, and I am senior to all the permanent unpassed

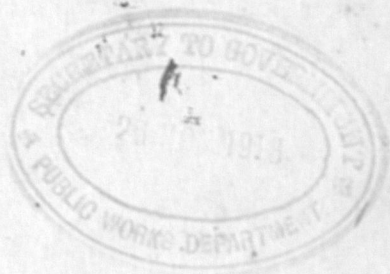
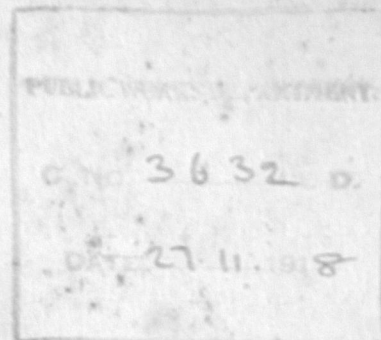

Extract from the letter, dated 8-11-1910, No. 485-S., from Rao Bahadur M.R.Py. A.V. Ramalinga Ayyar A.V., B.A., B.C.E., Executive Engineer, Kistna Western Division, to the Supg. Engineer, II Circle:-

I have the honour to bring to your notice the claims of the following members of the clerical staff of this Division for your special consideration:-

(3) P. Seetharamayya. - He is an unpassed candidate who studied up to the Matriculation standard, with more than 12 years service in the Department as a clerk throughout his service. His age is about 35 years. He has worked in this division in almost all the branches, exceptionally a very smart young man. In accounts matters, he has got special aptitude; writes beautifully short but good business drafts; and turns out double the quantity of work in a very short time when compared with the average work of any clerk. And I believe he would be an excellent Head Clerk of a sub division office to manage it splendidly well. I therefore strongly recommend that he may be exempted from the operation of Examination Rules to the next higher grade of 20--2--30, in consideration of the good work rendered in this division; and particularly in the interests of public service. I believe there are several precedents like this, and Government has been pleased to accord sanction in various cases, on several occasions. His case deserves your special consideration.

Letter No. 121-S., dated 5-6-1900, from J.M. Lacey Esq., B.C.E., Executive Engineer, Kistna Western Division, to the Superintending Engineer, II Circle.

With reference to your letter No. 84-K.W., dated 23-5-1900 I have the honour to inform you, that P. Seetharamayya, and * * are both men of 4½ years standing in the department, and have considerable experience in clerical work. The former P. Seetharamayya, despatching clerk, is one of the best clerks in the division office, and the only one who can write a

decent hands. It is extremely difficult to get passed men, or qualified men here, and I request that Government may be again addressed on the matter and their exemption, especially in the case of P. Seetharamayya, made permanent. It will be very difficult to replace him.

I may point out that the exemptions have been made in a peculiar manner--men with only a few years service, as in the case of * * * *, have been exempted, while men with 4 or 5 years service have not been exempted, or in other words, as soon as a man has gained experience in work, and become really useful he has to go. If we could get passed men there would be no need for entertaining unpassed men, but as I have pointed out above, this is a difficult matter in this division. Having entertained an unpassed man, and trained him in his work, it falls hard both on the man, and the office to have to send him away, when he is becoming really useful. I request therefore that the matter may be reconsidered, and clerks P. Seetharamayya, & **** might be exempted P. Seetharamayya, being permanently exempted.

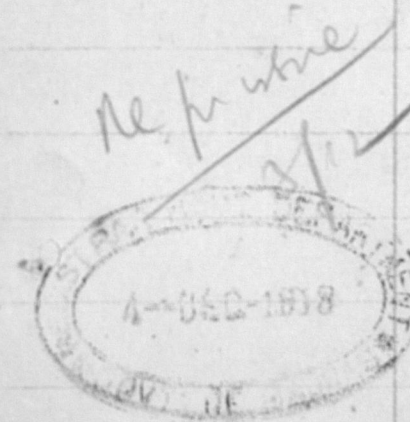
