I have the honour to request that you will be so good as to obtain the sanction of Government, for exempting N. Devarajulu Nayudu from the operations of article 1 of the Public Service Notification, with a view to his holding the post of a clerk in the Government Fisheries Department.

2. N. Devarajulu Nayudu belongs to the Community of Kamma, recognized by Government, as very backward in education and hardly represented in the Superior service of Government. He has studied up to the Matriculation class and, though he has not passed the General Educational Test, his general knowledge and experience is in no way inferior to that of an average passed candidate. He holds a permanent post as attender on Rs14/- in this department. and he

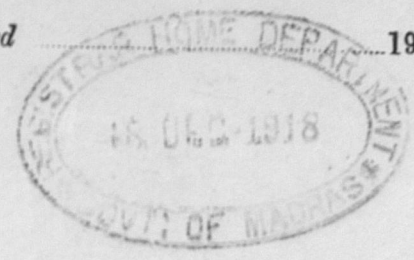

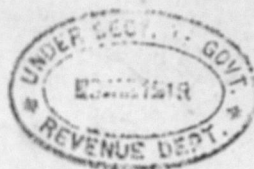

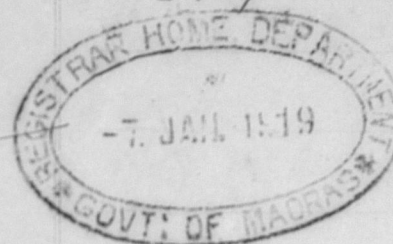
