As the sanction accorded in G.O. No. 1434 Home (Education) dated 15th November 1917 to the continuance of the additional teacher on Rs. 10/- per mensem employed in the Government Muhammadan Elementary School for boys, Chetty's garden, Madras, will expire by 31st December 1918, I have the honour to request that you will be so good as to obtain the sanction of Government for the permanent retention of the teacher's post with effect from 1st January 1919.

Rs. 15, 12 and 2(10) to manage efficiently five classes, of which the first containing 56 pupils requires to be placed under 2 teachers and the permanent retention of the temporary or teacher is therefore quite necessary. The Inspector of Schools 4th Circle, accordingly recommends that the temporary additional teachers' post on Rs. 10/- be permanently retained with effect from 1-1-1919 and his recommendation has my support.

3. The necessary provision for the charge has been made in the current and ensuing years' Budget Estimates.

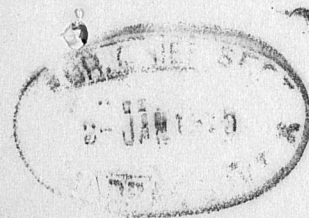
