At the instance of the District Medical and Sanitary Officer, Chingleput, the Superintendent of the Reformatory school, Chingleput reports that pupil No. 408 Ramaswami is suffering from tuberculosis of the right lung and that steps should be taken for his early discharge. The boy who is a native of Bangalore was committed to the Reformatory school for 5 years by the Second Presidency Magistrate, Madras and was admitted into the Reformatory school on 13-8-18. WHEREAS Ramaswamy was on the 12th day of August 1918 duly convicted before the undersigned Presidency Magistrate in and for the Town of Madras on a charge of having on or about the 24th day of July 1918 in Georgetown of Madras aforesaid committed house-breaking by night by thrusting hands into the door plank of the Shop of Pu 2 Shauk Hyder and committed theft of 3 Shirts in the said Shop valued Rs 3-12-0 belonging to him, after previous conviction, an offence punishable under Secs 457, 380 and 75 I.P.C.

and was sentenced to suffer rigorous Imprisonment for a term of three (3) months, and instead of undergoing the above sentence he will be sent to the Reformatory School at Chingleput and be detained there for a period of 5 (five) years or until he attains the age of 18.

You are hereby required to receive the said

Ramaswamy into your custody in the Reformatory School Chingleput Criminal Jail at Madras together with this warrant and there carry the aforesaid sentence into execution according to law.
