Dear Mr. Ramachandra Rao,

I am venturing to write a line regarding G.O.No.

- (B) 1515 dated the 16th December 1920, regarding Mr. Stephens's pay while acting as Headmaster, as I think there must be some mistake. I take it that the Government are quite willing that Mr. Stephens should draw as much as he can, subject to the Regulations being adhered to. Mr. Stephens's permanent pay as Second Master is Rs.350/- a month under G.O.No.774 dated 3rd July 1920. The Headmaster's permanent pay under the same G.O. is Rs.500/- a month. I take it therefore under article 105 (1) that Mr. Stephens while doing the two works is clearly eligible for his own pay Rs.350/- plus an allowance of one fifth of Rs.500/- that is Rs.100/- making Rs.450/- in all. As Mr. Stephens has done excellent work during this period, the Committee are very anxious that he should be given everything for which he is eligible and I should be glad if you would kindly let me know whether the Committee may pay him this sum.
