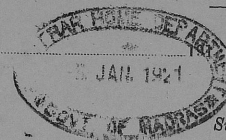

Sir,

I have the honour to submit copy of letter from the Inspector of European Schools, Madras, R.C. No. 695/20, dated 14th September 1920 and to request the sanction of Government for holding the exhibition proposed and for an expenditure not exceeding Rs. 500/- to meet incidental charges such as cost for removing exhibits from one place to another, arranging furnitures, lighting charges, freight for returning the exhibits to managers of schools, etc. The expenditure will be met from the current year's provision for 'other contingencies' under 22 B. Education, Government Schools, General, Secondary Schools for Boys. The Inspector of European Schools has been told to

minimise the expenses and to submit details of the actual expenditure incurred after the exhibition is over.

2. As the exhibition is proposed to be held in the Senate House from the 6th to 8th January 1921, I request the favour of very early orders on this letter.

Copy of letter from the Inspector of European Schools, Madras, A.C. No. 695/20, dated 14th September 1920.

I have the honour to inform you that at a meeting of the heads of European Schools in Madras held in this office on the 4th September 1920 it was decided, subject to your approval, to hold an exhibition of the work done in European Schools for the sake of teachers and others interested in the schools.

Exhibitions in Needlework and Drawing have been held in previous years on a small scale at the European Special Subjects Training Centre. The proposed exhibition will be on a larger scale and will include school-room work. Publishers will also be asked to send school books etc. relating to the different subjects of the curriculum. The date has been provisionally fixed for the 6th, 7th and 8th January and it is hoped that it will be possible to secure the Senate House for the exhibition. It was resolved to ask the Bangalore schools, through the Inspector of Schools, 13th Circle, to co-operate.

All the schools in the Presidency have responded with enthusiasm to the idea. I have the honour to ask for your approval, and at the same time for your sanction to utilising a sum not exceeding Rs. 500/- from the allotment of Rs. 1,200/- provided under stipends to apprentices in Manual Training Class to meet expenditure that may occur in connection with the exhibition.

Copies of the circulars issued to the schools are submitted.
