Copy of letter from the Headmaster, Government Muhammadan College, dated 14th October 1920.

I most respectfully beg to state that I was in charge of the Government Muhammadan College from the 2nd of July to the 26th of September 1920.

I further beg to add that during this period my work and responsibility had considerably increased, especially as the temporary assistant sanctioned in G.O. No. 209, dated 14th August 1920 and communicated in your Proceedings R.C. No. 6729/20, dated 2-9-1920 did not join duty.

Under the circumstances I pray that under Article 161, C.S.R. you will be pleased to grant me a charge allowance at the rate of not less than Rs. 65/- a month, i.e., one-tenth of the sanctioned pay of the Principal.

G.O. No. 272/20, dated 14th October 1920.

Submitted to the Director of Public Instruction and strongly recommended.

2. There can be no doubt that Mr. Mohammad had greater responsibility and more work during my absence and he well deserves the charge allowance asked for.

3. I may point out that money is available, as I draw Rs. 650/- per mensem while on leave, whereas Rs. 850/- per mensem is the budget allotment.

There is no audit objection to Government sanctioning a charge allowance of Rs40/- per mensem under article 161 of the Civil Service Regulations to Muhammad Sahib Bahadur, Headmaster, Madrasa-i-Azam, -i.e., 1/10 th of the pay he would get if appointed substantively in the Indian Educational Service- for the period from 2nd July to 10th September 1920 during which he was considered to have been in charge of the office of the Principal during the absence of Mr. Douglas on leave if they consider that the additional charge entailed a substantial increase of responsibility and ^{some} additional work.

3. For the period Muhammad Sahib Bahadur was in charge after the date the orders on Government Government of India Resolution No. 2097 C.S.R. dated 27-11-1920 take effect. viz., from the 11th to 26th September 1920, he may be granted such officiating allowance as Government may think fit provided his total allowances do not exceed Rs400 per mensem.

4. The officer is now in receipt of a pay of Rs350/- per mensem.

been deputed to do the duties of
Principal and English Lecturer. The
