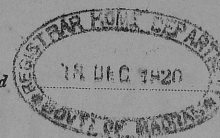

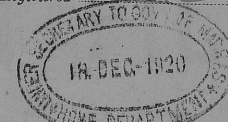

from the District Judge, Salem, to the Registrar, High
Court, Madras.

I have the honour to request that the High Court may
be pleased to obtain the sanction of the Government per-
manently exempting A. Ratna Mudali, a second grade amin of
the Namakal District Munsif's Court, from the examination
rules for holding the post of a first grade amin on Rs. 25.
He has put in a service of 29 years and has been an amin
for 25 years, 1 month and 27 days to-day. He can speak
and write English well having passed the late Middle School
Examination in the Second Class and has given satisfaction
as a clerk and as Assistant Nazir in which latter capacity
he was employed for three months. He is a Non-Brahmin
of the Vellala Mudali caste. His work and conduct as an
amin have been good. He is the amin with the longest
service in this district and I strongly recommend his
exemption.

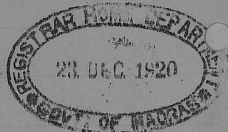

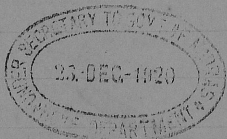
