Sir,

I have the honour to state that the Inspector of Schools, 6th circle, strongly recommends additional accommodation for the hostel attached to the Government Higher Elementary Training School, Saidapet on the ground that there is a likelihood of the strength of the hostel increasing still further than it is at present. In march 1919 the strength of the hostel was 31, in March 1920 44 and in July 1920, 49, and the Headmaster reports that there is a prospect of the strength raising to 60 if additional accommodation is provided. The school and the hostel attached to it are now located in different buildings on a monthly rental of Rs. 54/ and Rs. 37½ respectively. The proposed rent for the additional accommodation now required is fixed at Rs. 25 per mensem as certified by

the Public Works Department. As the aggregate rent for the buildings to be utilised for the school and the hostel comes to Rs. 117 per mensem, I request that you will be so good as to obtain the sanction of Government for incurring an expenditure of Rs. 117/ per mensem towards the rent charges for the school and the hostel attached to it.

2. The additional expenditure involved may be met from the anticipated savings under "Stipends of Students" in the current years budget.

Sir,

With reference to Government memorandum No.2549A-2

dated 30th September 1920 I have the honour to submit herewith 3 rough plans marked A, B and C. Plan A shows the amount and nature of accommodation available in the present rented building engaged partly for the location of the model school classes and partly for the hostel; Plan B shows the relative positions of the school, the present rented hostel building and the proposed one, and C the amount and the nature of the ^{additional} accommodation proposed to be provided.

2. The 14 living rooms in the present hostel building are barely sufficient for 29 students while the proposed additional building will accommodate 20 students conveniently. Though the strength of the hostel has ^{gone} down to 37 the Inspector ~~XXXXX~~ reports that this is

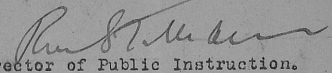
not because there are no more students who want to live in the hostel but because the students know that they cannot get admission for -- want of room and the Inspector expects that the strength will rise to 50 if additional accommodation is provided.

3. I agree with the Inspector and accordingly repeat the recommendation in my letter R.C.No.6794 of 1920 dated 24th August 1920 to rent the proposed building for a rent of Rs.25/- per mensem.

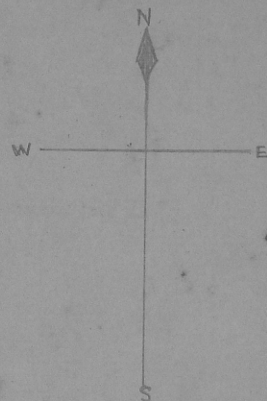

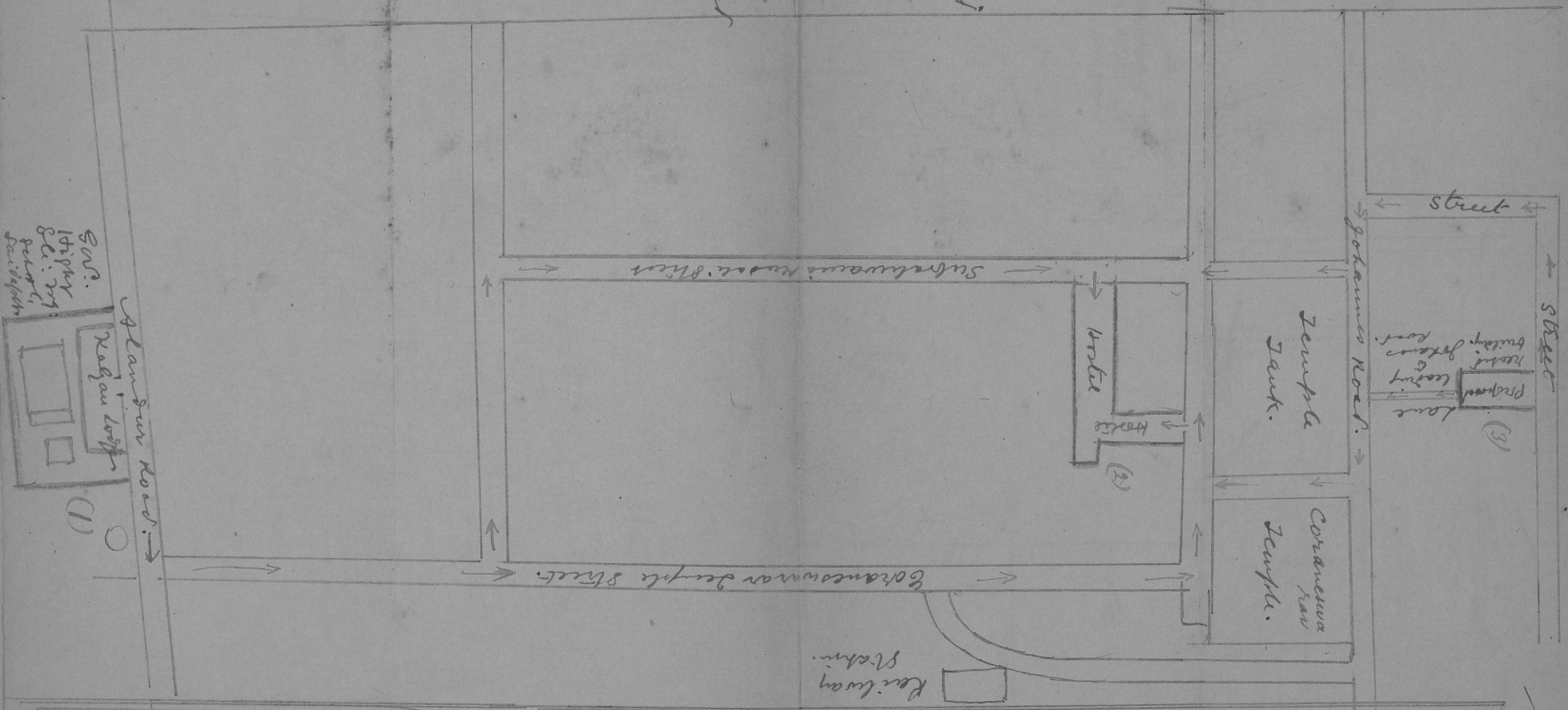
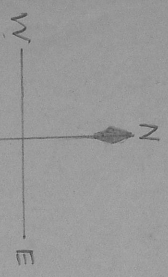

Sakun, Sacatopok.

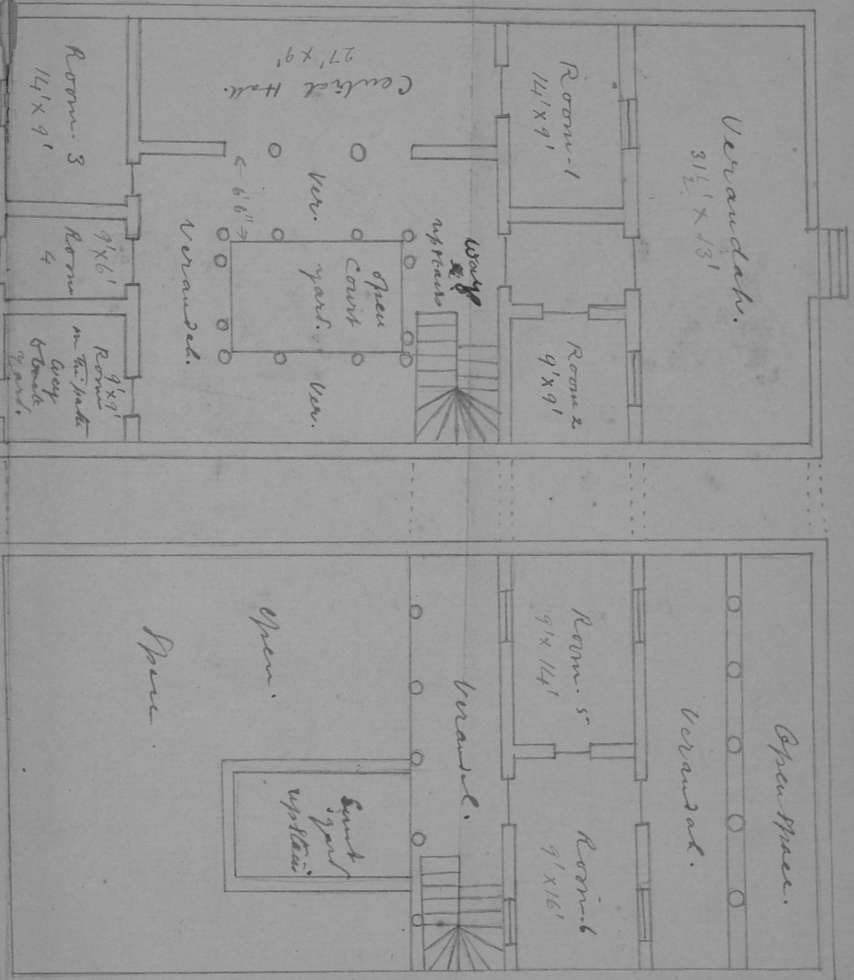

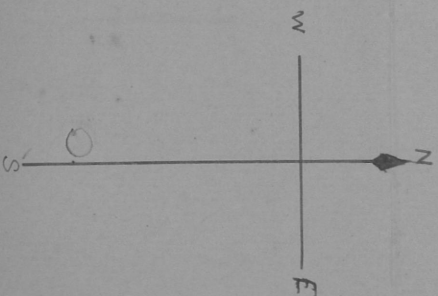

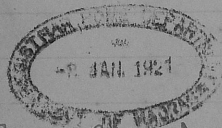
