Reference.-

The Special Settlement Officer, Party No. III, recommends that H. Subba Rao and B.L. Narayana Rao, permanent classifiers on Rs.30 and temporary Superintendents on Rs. 50 plus 15 each, may be exempted permanently from the provisions of article 1 of the Public Service Notification with a view to their being appointed as Head Classifiers. Both of them are well acquainted with the details of settlement work and are capable of drawing intelligible conclusions.

In these circumstances and having regard to the fact that there are no other suitable candidates in the Party for the posts of Head Classifier, the Board supports the Special Settlement Officer's recommendation and submits it for the sanction of Government.

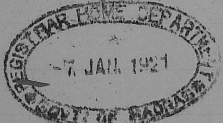
