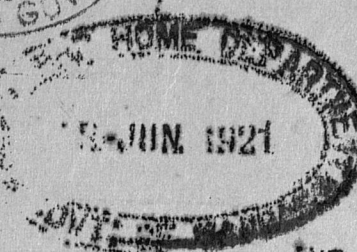

My Lord,

I have the honour to inform Your Lordship that a Swedish Oriental Society (Svenska Orientsallskapet) was formed at Stockholm yesterday, with His Royal Highness the Crown Prince as President, the Archbishop of Sweden, Dr. Nathan Soderblom as Vice President, Dr. T.J. Arne, Secretary, and Mr. E. Nylander (Director of the General Export Association of Sweden) as Treasurer. The rest of the Committee consists of University people interested in oriental matters, and business men with practical interests in the Orient among the latter being Mr. Dan Bostrom of Gothenburg.

The Society hopes to be able to help in research work, and its spheres of labour will be Eastern and Central Asia, India, the Near East, Northern Africa and those parts of Europe which have been in close touch with the East, such as the Balkan Peninsula and the Black Sea District. The Society will also endeavour to arrange courses in modern Eastern languages for business men, export stipendiaries etc. to establish a Swedish Research Institute, to arrange popular lectures and issue publications on oriental questions. It is hoped moreover that a purely scientific activity on the part of the Society in the Orient and South Eastern Europe will also tend to spread a knowledge of Sweden in oriental circles and thereby further Sweden's economic interests in these countries.
