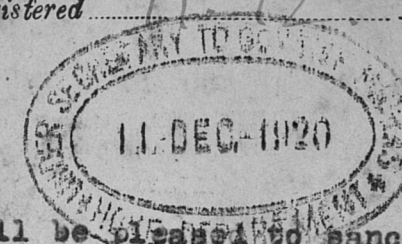

Sir,

In the proposition statement relating to the Government Madrasa-i-Azam, approved in G.O.No.498 Home(Education) dated 17th April 1919 provision was made for the following scale of munshis:-

Persian Munshi.	Rs.60- 3/2 --75.
Arabic Munshi.	Rs.60-3/2-- 75.
Hindustani Munshi.	Rs.40-2/2 -- 50.
Tamil Munshi.	Rs.40-2/2 -- 50.

For sometime prior to the introduction of the model school scheme, however, the Arabic and Tamil Munshis had been holding a post on Rs.60-3/2-75 each while the Hindustani and Persian Munshis had been holding a post on Rs.40-2/2-50 each. I consulted the Accountant General as to whether there was any objection to the continuance of this arrangement, as otherwise the Tamil munshi would have to revert

to the scale 40-2/2-50. The Accountant-General has informed me that the variations of the rates of pay of the four munshis, specifically fixed in the proposition statement referred to above, require the -- sanction of Government. The Tamil munshi in question is by far the seniormost among the four munshis, and the grant of a personal allowance to him will not meet the needs of the case. Nor is there any need for attaching particular salaries to particular posts of munshis in the ~~Madrassa~~ Madrasa-i-Azam. The higher rates of pay may be given ordinarily to munshis who have put in comparatively longer -- ~~The Government is requested that Govt will be pleased to sanction~~ service. To enable me to do this I have in partial modification of the proposition statement approved in G.O.No.498 Home(Education) -- dated 17th April 1919 ~~the honour to request that Government will be pleased to sanction~~ two posts of munshis on a scale of Rs.60-3/2-75 each and two posts of munshis on a scale of Rs.40-2/2-50 in the --- place of the four posts of munshis attached to the school. My proposal does not involve any extra expenditure.
