3. With reference to the question of including Professors of Mechanical Engineering in the Engineering College in the Industrial Service, H.M. (Financial) has noted as follows:--

"As regards Professors in the Engineering College we had recently a file in which, if I remember -- rightly, we were asked to undertake a large increase in expense on account of the unwillingness of the officers of the P.W.D. to be deputed to the college. If any of these officers were deputed for work -- connected with mechanical engineering, it would -- certainly seem desirable to replace them by officers of the new Department".

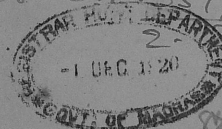
We have no information if any of the P.W.D. officers are now employed in the Engineering college. 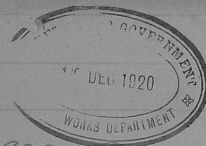


It is submitted that there ^{has been no correspondence} ~~no correspondence~~ in this Dept such as that referred to at to on the previous page. There is only one post of Professor of Mechanical engineering in the College of Engineering ^{included in the DES} ~~in the DES~~. Mr C.H. Cartwright is the permanent incumbent of the post. He went on leave last year. The P.W.D. was not able to spare the services of any officer of that Dept to act for him. Mr R. S. Subrahmanyam, a Sub-Engineer of the P.W.D., who was employed as Inspector in the Vizagapatam Engineering School, was temporarily transferred to the College, his post at Vizagapatam being left unfilled. The Secretary of State was also asked to recruit a candidate from England to act for Mr Cartwright. He, however, ^(replied) that recruitment from England for a temporary vacancy was not possible. Mr Cartwright returned to India in July last & ^{has} ~~has~~ since then been appointed to act as Principal in place of Mr James granted leave. As the P.W.D.

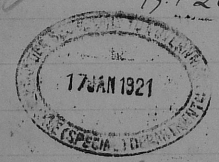

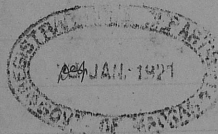

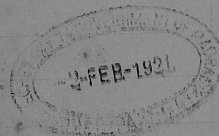
