With reference to G.O. No. 293 /dated the 10th March 1921  
sanctioning the re-appointment of Rao Sahib S. Krishnaswami  
Aiyangar, M.A., as University Professor of Indian History and  
Archaeology for a further term of 5 years, I have the honour, by  
direction, to inform you that the Syndicate has had under consi-  
deration an application from the Professor for an enhancement of  
the maximum of his present salary of Rs500-50-1,000 to Rs1,250  
to bring it into uniformity with the salary of the University  
Professor of Indian Economics. The Syndicate, while declining  
to grant the request, has resolved that the Professor, who is at  
present drawing Rs800 per mensem as pay, exclusive of a pensionary  
contribution of Rs80, in the sanctioned scale of Rs500-50-1,000,  
be granted an immediate increase of pay by two annual increments  
without prejudice to the pensionary contribution and that he be  
entitled to the next annual increment on the 1st November 1921,  
and that the maximum pay of the appointment remain unaltered.  
The approval of the Senate for the proposed immediate increase  
of the officer's salary by two increments has been obtained at  
its last meeting held on the 4th instant. I am now directed to  
request that the Government (will also) be pleased to accord their  
sanction to the proposal.

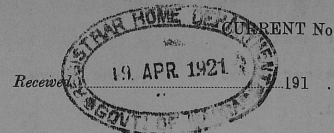

SIR,

With reference to Government Endorsement No.1038 B-1 dated the 30th March 1921, forwarding to me for remarks letter No.2529 dated the 22nd March 1921 from the Registrar of the University of Madras, I have the honour to state that there is no audit objection to Government sanctioning the proposal of the Syndicate (i) to grant an immediate increase in the pay of Professor Rao Sahib S. Krishnaswami Ayyangar, M.A., F.R.H.S. by two annual increments without prejudice to the payment by the University of his pensionary contribution to the Mysore Government, (ii) to allow the Professor his next annual increment on the 1st November 1921, and (iii) to restrict the maximum pay of the appointment to Rs.1,000/-per month.

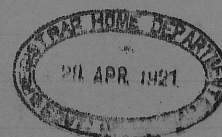
