Sir,

I have the honour to submit herewith copies of letters R.C.No.170 D.B of 1921 dated 4-2-21 and R.C.No.171/E.T.B of 20 dated 14-1-21, from the President District Board, Kistna and to the President, Taluk Board, Ellore and to state as follows.

It is recommended that the transfer of Rs.2710 from the Rs.5000 sanctioned in G.O.No.333 Home(Education) dated 16-3-20 for the building of the Tallapudi School, for the completion of the school buildings at Peddavaram and Kotakoteswar, be temporarily allowed, on the understanding that as stated by the ~~President~~ Resident Taluk Board in the last paragraph of his letter the amount of Rs.2710 transferred now will be retransferred from the Taluk Board funds, when the construction of the -

the building for the Tallapudi school is begun.

From the figures sent by the President an amount of Rs.2710 is required for the completion of the 2 buildings ~~and out of~~ Rs.2760 as stated in his letter under reference. p 3 sup

Copy of letter R.C.No.170 D.B of 1921 dated 4-2-21, from the President, District Board, Kistna to the Director of Public Instruction, Madras.

" In forwarding herewith a copy of letter R.C.No.171 D.B of 1920, dated 5-1-1921 together with its enclosures from the President, Taluk Board, Ellore, I have the honour to request that you will be good enough to accord necessary sanction for the utilisation of the grant of Rs.2760 out of the grant -- sanctioned for the Tallapudi school building on the Peddavam and the Katakoteswaram school buildings as proposed by the President, Taluk Board, Ellore. "

Copy of letter R.C.No.171/D.B of 1920 dated 14-1-21 from the President, Taluk Board, Ellore to the President, District Board, Kistna.

In submitting herewith a copy of T.B.R No.458, dated 23-12-20 sanctioning the transfer of Rs.2760/- from the subsidy of Rs.5000, made in G.O.No.333 dated 16th March 1920 for the construction of a school building at Tallapudy for the completion of construction of school buildings at peddavam and Kotakoteswaram, I have the honour to bring to your notice that a subsidy of Rs.4390 as detailed in the margin

(Y) G.O.No.203, dated 15-2-1919 was sanctioned by Government for the construction of Rs.2140.

(K) G.O.No.368, dated 22-3-1919. the latter two -- Constructing a school building at Katakoteswaram school buildings Rs.2250. and that estimates Rs.4390.

for these two buildings were sanctioned by the Board in the year 1918 duly adopting the rates as per schedule of rates for that year. The work of Peddavam school building was actually commenced in the year 1919-20 and the rates were therefore allowed as per

per schedule of rates for 1919-20 for the work done in that year and duly adopting the rates as per current schedule of rates for the work done during the current year. The construction of the school building at Kotakoteswaran is commenced during the ~~year~~ current year. The rates have been revised as per current schedule of rates.

Further the accommodation in the two buildings under construction having been found insufficient owing to the subsequent improvement in the schools, the Taluk Board had to call for revised estimates as per current schedule of rates for providing for larger accommodation by way of extension.

Revised estimates for Rs.3300 and Rs.3,600 for the -- construction of these two buildings have accordingly been received. The amounts of the revised estimates could not possibly be -- curtailed since all the items provided therein are absolutely necessary. The excess amount of Rs.2760/- required for these two works is therefore resolved by the Board to be transferred from the allotment of Rs.5000 given for the construction of the school building at Tallapudi since no estimate has yet been received from the Local Fund District Engineer for this building in spite of my repeated requests since last 1½ years and as -- there is no likelihood of the whole allotment being spent on that work in the current year even if the estimate is prepared ~~now~~.

I therefore request you to be good enough to obtain the sanction of the District Board and of the Government if necessary for the transfer of the allotment as ~~resolved~~ resolved by the Board in its resolution quoted supra. So there will be only Rs.2240 outstanding for the construction of the building at Tallapudi. This school also has since improved and the strength of the school is now between 180 & 200. So we will have to provide for a more spacious building entailing a cost of Rs.7000. So I request that you will kindly recommend to Government for a grant of another Rs.5000 for the said school building.

In case the Government is not pleased to approve the

the transfer of allotment, the amount so transferred from the allotment given for the construction of the Tallapudi school building will be retransferred from General funds to the work when the same is actually put into execution. A site measuring Acl-80 cents for the construction of the same was also acquired at a cost of nearly Rs.700 by the Taluk Board in the year 1917 and the construction of the building will be commenced soon after the estimate asked for from the Local Fund District Board Engineer is received in this office.
