Sir,

In submitting herewith a copy of letter No.477 N.C. of 20 dated 4-5-20 from the President District Board, Salem and of my reply to him R.C.No.4900/20 dated 14-7-20 regarding the grant of a special scholarship and fee remission to a panchama boy I have the honour to state that the President informs me that the pupil in question was admitted into the IV class of the Shevapet Town School which is a branch of the Salem College on the afternoon of 2nd November 1920 and requests that a scholarship and a fee remission may be sanctioned on behalf of the pupil. As the special scholarships for Panchamas sanctioned in G.O.No.

(K) No. 1038 Home (Education) dated 28-8-19 are tenable only in forms I to VI. I have the honour to request the sanction of Government to the award of ^a Government scholarship of the monthly value of Rs. 3/- together with fee remission to the pupil for his course in the IV class. The scholarship and fee remission may be continued next year on his securing promotion to the V class.

2. The scholarship due to the pupil from 2-11-20 will be disbursed during the official year 1921-22. The amount required for 1920-21 and 1921-22 can be met from the provision for scholarships in Secondary schools made in the Budget estimate for 1921-22.

3. Under rule 102 of the Madras Educational Rules the pupil need pay only half the standard rate of fees. The amount of fee income foregone from the pupil will be paid to the Municipal Council, Salem as a subsidy.

Copy of letter No. 477 N.O. of 20 dated 4th May 1921, from the President, District Board, Salem to the Director of Public Instruction, Madras.

I have the honour to state that one K.M. Rangaswami, a panchama pupil of the IV standard in the Board Elementary school at Katchupalli in the Tiruchengode Taluk has put in a petition to me representing that there are no higher standards than the 4th in the school that he feels anxious to continue his studies up to the school final class that he may therefore be sent to Salem or Madras for education in any secondary school and may be allowed a scholarship of Rs. 20/- per mensem towards his boarding clothing and other charges. His father is a Talayari in the Revenue department getting only Rs. 4 per month and hence he is not able to meet the cost of his son's higher education. Neither the Taluk Board nor the District Board is able to find funds out of its resources wherewith the assistance sought for by the poor panchama pupil could be rendered. The Headmaster of the school recommends that a scholarship of Rs. 20/- per mensem may be allowed to the pupil in as much as he comes out of the poor panchama community and is moreover intelligent and industrious enough and longs for secondary education. In the circumstances I recommend that the request of the pupil may be favourably considered and a scholarship of Rs. 20/- per mensem during term time may be sanctioned to him from provincial funds."

With reference to your letter No.477 R.C. of 20 dated 4-5-20 recommending a special scholarship of Rs.20/- per mensem to one K.M.Rangaswami a panchama pupil reading in the IV standard in the Board Elementary school, Katchupalli, ~~Trichi~~ Tiruchengode Taluk to enable him to continue his studies, I have the honour to state that I am prepared to sanction or seek the sanction of Government for the grant of a scholarship to the boy at the ordinary rate for panchama pupils sanctioned in G.O.No.1038 & E. dated 28-8-19 i.e) Rs.3/- per mensem in forms I to III plus full fee remissions. I request that you will be good enough to select ~~in~~ the school which the boy may conveniently join and to ~~invite~~ intimate the fact to me.

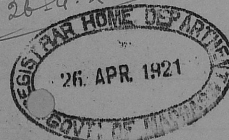

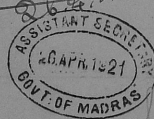
