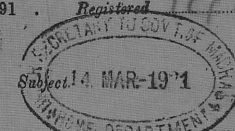

In G.O.No. 226 Home, Education, dated 21st Feb. 18

Government sanctioned the continuance for a further period of 3 years from 1st July 18 of the post of Additional Professor in the ninth grade of the Provincial Educational Service in the Presidency Collegesanctioned tentatively for a period of three years in G.O. No. 533, Educational dated 18th May 1915 with a view to relieving the Principal of a portion of his lecturing work. This sanction expires by the 30th June 1921. The arrangement has been working satisfactorily and the principal requests its continuance. The post has been in existence now for nearly six years and its continuance has proved its necessity. I have accordingly the honor to request the sanction of Government for its permanent retention.
