I have the honour to communicate the following resolutions passed at a special meeting of the Teachers' Guild held on the 18th March 1921 in the Hindu High School Triplicane:-

1. The Madras Teachers' guild views with extreme surprise and disappointment that no provision has been made in the Budget for special grants to teachers in aided institutions in spite of the representations made to the Government by a large number of Teachers' associations.

2. The Madras Teachers Guild requests that in view of the large number of institutions being aided, the Minister for Education be pleased so to revise the Budget as to provide adequate funds for immediate relief to the extent of 7 lakhs of Rupees as stated in its memorandum submitted to him on 7th March 1921, to teachers in aided institutions.

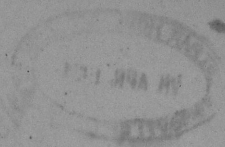

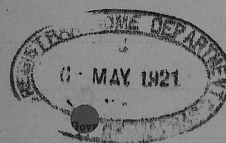
