Sir,

I am directed to request that, if there is no objection, separate statistics for the 'night schools' in your province may be supplied in future annual reports.

2. By the term 'night school' is to be understood any school or class held after working hours and attended by adults or youths (men or women) employed as full-time workers in trade, business or other occupations. A typical example would be the Evening Continuation Classes in typewriting, etc., conducted by the Young Men's Christian Association. The term should not include part-time schools for factory children.

3. Figures for 'night schools' are already collected in all major provinces and included in Table III. It is requested that this practice be followed in all provinces; the figures for schools and scholars being included under the appropriate headings, e.g., primary schools, commercial schools, etc. in columns 18 and 19 of the table.

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It is undesirable to complicate this table by the addition of other columns. The figures for night schools should accordingly be amalgamated with the figures given in the table for other schools of each grade. But separate information with regard to these institutions should be conveyed in a footnote to this table to the following effect:- "Includes night schools attended by scholars," references being given by asterisks to the items in columns 18 and 19 in which the figures for night schools have been included.

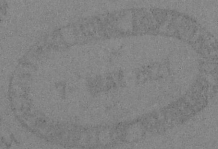
