I.C.S., Collector of Ganjam, R.C. No. 171/Cor/21, dated

the 24th January 1921:-

Korlapu Krishnamurti, Clerk, Deputy Tahsildar's

Office, Kudala, was first entertained in Government service

in the year 1896 and was confirmed on Rs. 20/- in October

1910.

In the year 1913 his services were lent to the Khallikote Estate where he acted as Head Clerk under the Special Tahsildar on Rs. 40/-. As the Estate was recently handed over to the Zamindar, the clerk has to revert to his permanent post on Rs.20/- in the Government service.

As he is a Middle School 2nd class man he is not eligible for higher posts. He has put in a pensionable service of 19 years.

In consideration of his long service I request that the Board may be pleased to exempt him from the Examination Rules to hold clerical posts up to Rs. 40/- in the Government service.

2. The Board supports the recommendation of the Collector and requests that Government will be pleased to exempt the candidate from Article I of the Public Service Notification so as to enable him to hold a clerk's post the pay of which does not exceed Rs. 40/- per mensem.
