Copy of letter No.1697 dated 23rd April 1921 from the District Judge, Salem.

I have the honour to forward herewith for the orders of the High Court copy of a letter to me from the District Munsif of Namakkal, No.930 dated the 20th April 1921, praying that the High Court may be addressed to obtain the sanction of the Government permanently exempting T.R.Rangaswami Ayyangar, a clerk of the District Munsif's Court of Namakkal, from the Examination Rules for holding the post of a clerk on Rs.25. All the clerks on Rs.20 in the Namakkal District Munsif's Court are unpassed men and the clerk recommended by the District Munsif stands second in rank in that grade in point of service and knows English well, having passed the Lower Secondary Examination in the First Class. My predecessor, Mr. A. Fotheringham, exempted him temporarily for a year from the 10th July last, and as regards the efficiency of the clerk, I have nothing to add to the remarks of the District Munsif contained in the last paragraph of his letter.

Sir,

I have the honour to report that T.R.Rangasami Ayyangar, permanent 7th clerk on Rs. 20, was in District Court's Proceedings No.2839 dated 9-7-1920, appointed as temporary clerk on Rs. 25 on exemption from examination rules for one year from 10th July last under Rule 4(7a) of the Public Service Notification. In G.O.No.60 Law(General), dated the 8th instant, communicated to me with the District Court's endorsement No.1535, dated the 17th instant, the Government have sanctioned the retention of the temporary clerk on Rs. 25/- per mensem for a further period of one year from the 7th February last. As the clerk T.R.Rangasami Ayyangar is to continue in the temporary vacancy exceeding twelve months in duration, I have the honour to recommend (1) that under rule 4(4) of the Public Service Notification the sanction of the High Court may be kindly obtained for his employment on Rs. 25/- so long as the temporary vacancy lasts, and (2) that under rule 4(1) of the same Public Service Notification the sanction of the Government may be kindly obtained for his employment in any permanent post carrying a pay of Rs. 25/- and more.

2. I have found him an honest, industrious and efficient man deserving encouragement. He has put in a service of about 18 years in this Department and has passed the Lower Secondary Examination in the 1st class.

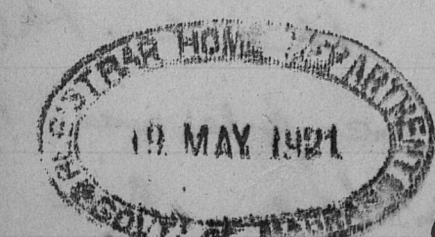
