There is some correspondence regarding this school in the office. Last month the Inspector reported that Mr. Swaminatha Pillai and his wife, who has had some practical experience of the work, are running the nucleus of a school with three defectives aged between 12 and 18 and that the Municipality have agreed, conditionally, to pay the rent for one year. It is reported that some influential gentlemen in the place are interesting themselves in the school and that efforts are being made to get a specially trained teacher. It is clear from the Inspector's report that he is doing all that he can and the suggestion that is implied in part (b) of the question that he is unsympathetic in the matter is not justified. The following reply is suggested:-
