In their ^{order} ~~order~~ No. 1263 Home (Education) dated 23rd September 1918, Government sanctioned a revised scale of staff of 3 teachers on Rs. 20, 15 and 12 (now 13) respectively per mensem, temporarily for a period of two years, for the Government Girls' School, Tiruvendipuram. The revised scale was introduced on 1st April 1919 and the sanction therefore expired by the 31st March 1921. I request that you will be so good as to obtain the sanction of Government for the permanent retention of the revised scale with effect from the

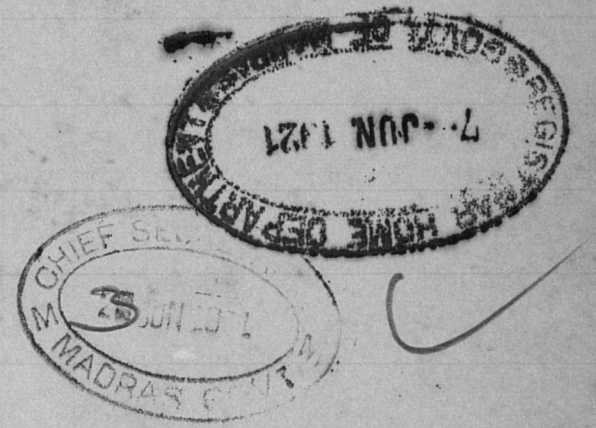

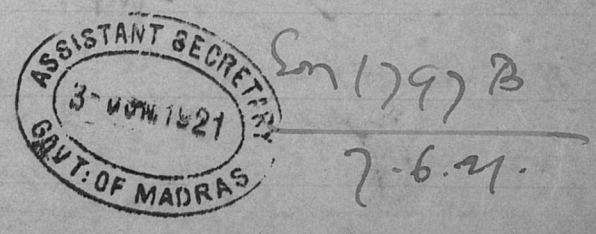
