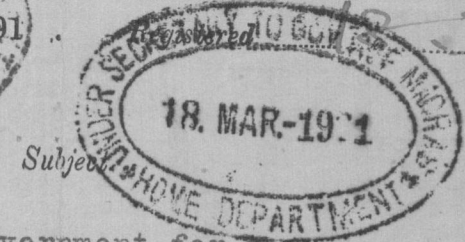
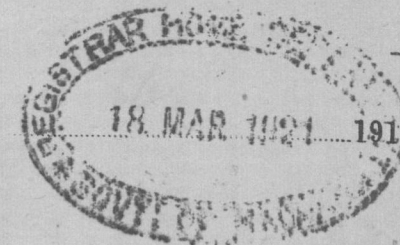

In G.O.No. 265 Education dated the 13th March 16 Government sanctioned along with two other posts, the creation of a temporary post of Assistant Lecturer in Sanskrit in the Presidency College in class IV of the Subordinate Educational Service - Collegiate Branch- and the sanction was renewed in G.O.No. 719, Home Education dated 9th June 1919 for a further period of two years ending with 30th June 1921. The appointment was created in connection with the affiliation of the college in Group VI - Sanskrit and Early Indian History and though the number of students taking this group has not been very encouraging, the Principal considers and I agree with him that the affiliation should be maintained. 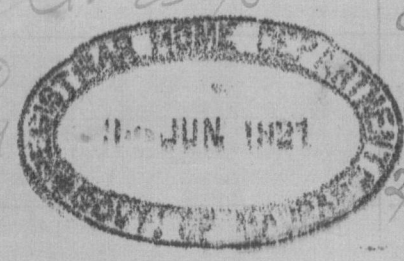

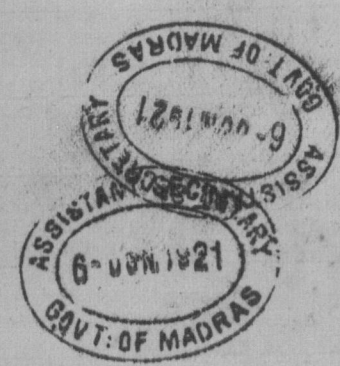
