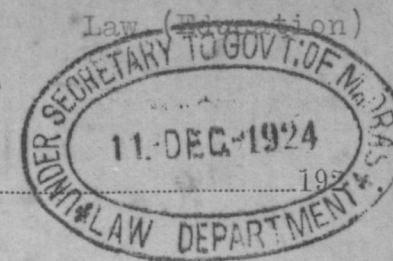

Sir,

I have the honour to submit herewith the statement showing the distribution of subsidies to District Boards in 1924-25 towards the maintenance of sessional schools and to offer the following remarks:-

(i) Chingleput and Salem

The Sessional schools in the Districts of Chingleput and Salem were closed from 1st April 1924 and hence no subsidy is recommended for payment to these District Boards.

(ii) North Arcot

Of the two sessional schools in this District the Hindu Sessional school has been closed from 1-7-24. The usual subsidy payable to this District Board for the two schools is Rs.3692 and a sum of Rs.2308 (Rs.1846 being half the usual subsidy

Rs. 1846 x 3 for the Muhammadan sessional schools plus Rs. 462, the proportionate
-Rs. 461 1/2 subsidy to the Hindu Sessional school for the three months
during which the school worked in the current year) is recommended
for payment.

(iii) South Arcot.

A sum of Rs. 2061 only is recommended for payment
as Government have in their order No. 1482 Mis., Law (Education) dated 19th September 1924 reduced the subsidy payable to the
District Board to Rs. 2061.

(iv) Kurnool.

The three sessional schools in this district were
closed in March 1924. But the President, District Board in
his letter R.C.No. 584/24 dated 28th September 1924 herewith sub-
mitted states that a sum of Rs. 378 was spent during the current
year on account of the working of the schools in March 1924
and I recommend that a subsidy of Rs. 378 may be sanctioned to the
District Board.

(v) Nellore.

The Sessional school in this district has been
closed from 1st March 1924 and the unspent balance of Rs. 31
with the District Board will be adjusted towards the subsidy
payable to the board for its Secondary schools.

(vi) Trichinopoly.

No subsidy is recommended for payment to this
District board as in Memo. No. 2570-A -3 Law (Education) dated
31st July 1924 Government directed that the subsidy payable
to the District Board should be discontinued from 1-4-24.

2. The total subsidy payable to the District Boards
in 1924-25 for the maintenance of Sessional schools amounts
to Rs. 21,405 and this may be met from the provision of Rs. 40,700
under 31 C(b)(iii) Education-Grants to Local Bodies for primary
Education - for payment to District Boards in support of sessional
schools.

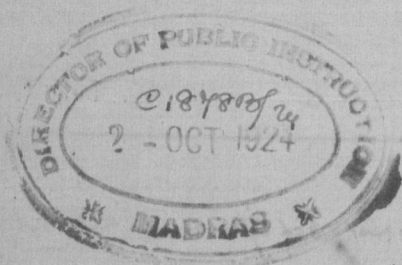

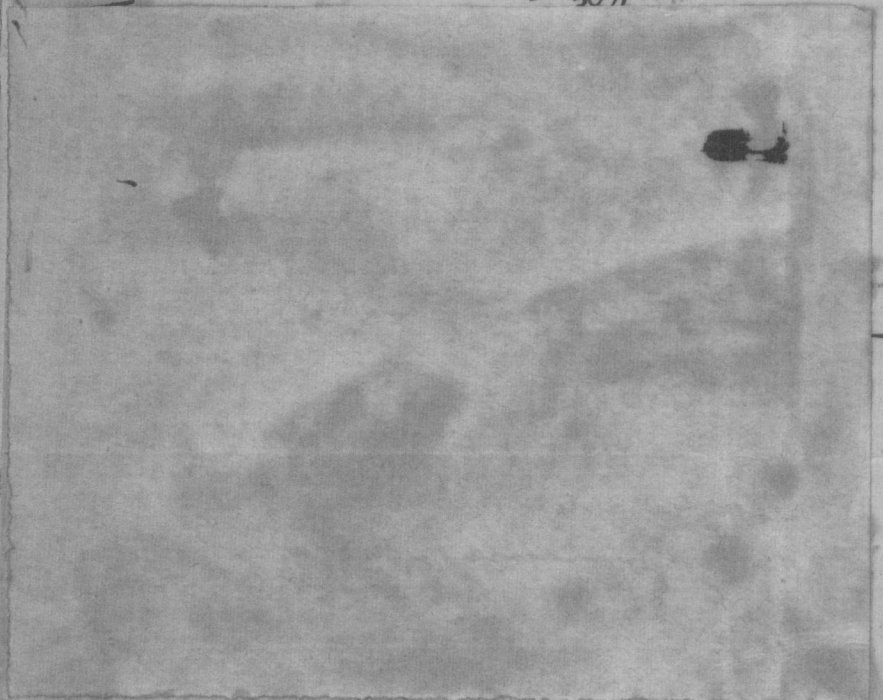

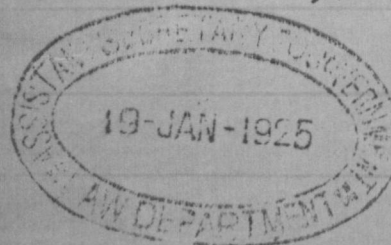
