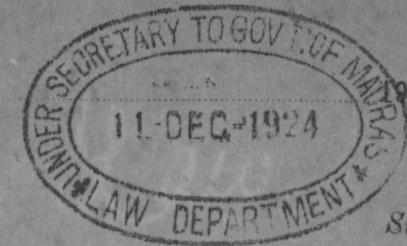

Sir,

I have the honour to state that in G.O. No. 1108
Law (Education) dated 17-2-23 Government sanctioned the
introduction of vocational training in Agriculture in the
U.F.C.M. High School, Chingleput and also ~~submitted~~ Sanctioned
therefor a grant of Rs. 2392 (Rs. 2144 for non-recurring
and Rs. 248 for recurring) during 1923-4.

2. The class ^{September} ~~was~~ begun on the 18th ~~1923~~ 1923 and a
non-recurring grant of Rs. 2058 and a recurring grant
of Rs. 214 only (being half the recurring charges up to
the end of February 1924) was paid to the management.

3. The correspondent now reports that 150 pupils

belonging

belonging to Forms III to VI are at present receiving instruction in Agriculture as against 191 during 23-24. It is reported that the pupils of Form II are not now given instruction in Agriculture as it has not been possible for 1 Instructor to undertake so many classes.

4. From the statement of recurring and non-recurring charges for the year 1924-25 submitted by the correspondent (a copy of which is herein enclosed for reference it will be seen that the amount under the former head comes to Rs.1212 and that under the latter to Rs.668/

5. The increase in the recurring cost is chiefly due to the correspondent's proposal to appoint an agricultural Instructor on Rs.25 per mensem ^{and} a maistry on Rs.15 per mensem.

6. The necessity for the appointment of an agricultural demonstrator on Rs.25 per mensem and a maistry on Rs.15 is explained by the correspondent in his report, an extract of which is herein enclosed.

7. As regards the charges of the class during 1924-25 the Adviser to Government on Manual and Vocational training who was consulted, is of opinion that the non-recurring charges may be reduced to Rs.568 and the recurring charges 1475. He is of opinion that the garden maistry on Rs.15 per mensem need not be considered.

8. As the correspondent has stated that charges on account of the agricultural demonstrator will begin to be incurred only after the necessary sanction is received, I consider that a sum of Rs.75 is enough under this head if sanction to employ the agricultural demonstrator is given with effect from 1-1-25. Further the question of a provident fund contribution from Government on behalf of the Agricultural Instructor does not arise nor do I consider that the increment claimed on behalf of the Instructor can be allowed seeing that the class

class is still on a temporary basis.

9. The recurring charges of the class during the current year will therefore amount to Rs.1205/- as per details given in the margin.

The classes taking part in the field work usually numbering over 40 at one time were much too large to be effectively supervised by the Agricultural Instructor. In order to carry on effectively the field work the appointment of an additional agricultural demonstrator and a gardener maistry is essential. The necessity for such additional help is rendered necessary not only for supervision of the practical work of the pupils in the field, but also for carrying on the necessary seasonal operations during the more lengthy periods of school holidays at Michaelmas, Christmas and during the summer vacation. In this respect agricultural differs from all other industries of a vocational nature. Crops have to be carefully watched to prevent depredations by men and animals and arrangements must be made to ensure the carrying out of necessary watering and cultivation during holidays. I would therefore request that Government sanction the entertainment of an Agricultural demonstrator on Rs.25 per month and a gardener maistry of Rs.15 a month which with necessary contingencies will amount to an additional Rs.500 per annum. In our original proposal for starting these classes we submitted proposals for the employment of a maistry gardener but this was evidently not sanctioned. The failure to recognise this very necessary expenditure has been very keenly felt during the preliminary months and involved considerable loss by theft and animal trespass. During the forenoons the Agricultural Instructor is engaged at the school and the pupils only come with him to the field work in the afternoons and do not stay after school hours (4 P.M.) With an additional demonstrator the pupils could be arranged in groups so that some of those who live near could come for ~~fix~~ field work in the early mornings or late afternoons when certain gardening processes such as watering should only be done. With the present staff of only one Agricultural instructor this
