Sir,

Under instructions given in G.O. No. 1397

dated 29th August 1924, separate Elementary Education account has been maintained from 1st October 1924 and it will be very difficult to deal with the whole branch by one clerk Hence the Board in its Resolution No. 4 dated 18th September 1924 (Copy enclosed) resolved to increase the staff by -- transferring one 3rd class clerk from the general office establishment and by appointing one additional 3rd class clerk temporarily for 6 months incurring the cost of the two clerks from the Education fund as in the case of --

provident fund establishment as laid down in appendix 1X article 21 (c) of the Local Board's Manual. Besides the Board as per instructions had adjusted to the Elementary Education fund the usual amount from the general revenue and it is difficult to manage the education clerks in addition. But the Assistant Examiner of Local Fund Accounts Northern circle, Guntur, in his letter L.F. Godi No.478 dated 22nd November 1924 (copy enclosed) had objected for this and informed that the sanction of Government should be obtained for this.

I therefore have the honour to request to accord sanction for meeting all expenditure incurred on behalf of Elementary Education, from the Education fund.

from the Assistant Examiner of Local Fund Accounts, Northern
Circle, Guntur, to the President Taluk Board, Ramachandrapur

Ref:- Your Memorandum Ref. Sup. Cur. No. 23 of 23 dated 9th
September 1924 and 16th October 1924, and the resolution of
your Taluk Board No. 4 dated 15th September 1924.

The proposal to transfer one third class clerk to
Elementary Education and to appoint one third class clerk
temporarily for 6 months so that the cost of both may be
charged to the Elementary Education fund cannot be admitted
in audit without specific sanction of Government. As under
the Madras Local Board Act 1920 the maintenance of Elemen-
tary Schools is one of the principal functions of the Taluk
Boards, the pay of the clerks attending to work connected
with elementary education should be met from the general
account only.

As the expenditure from the elementary education fund
should be regulated with reference to the sanctioned budget
of that fund for 1924-25 there is nothing in G.O. No. 955
Law (education) dated 12th June 1924 approving the budget
wanting the above expenditure.

I request I may be informed what action you propose
to take in the matter.

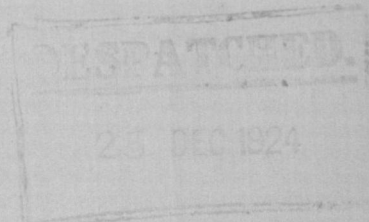
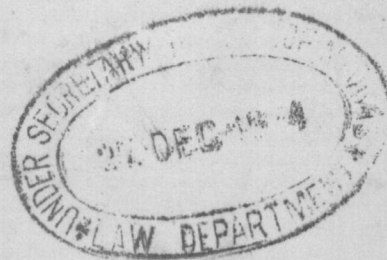

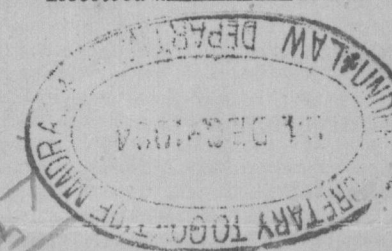

Sir,

Government have ordered in G. O. No. 978 Law (Education) dated 16th June 1924 that a separate account should be kept for the elementary education fund under the control of each local authority, ⁱⁿ distinct from the transactions relating to the general funds. Government have also ruled that the contribution once made to the elementary education fund from the general revenues should not be reduced without the sanction of Government, but should be merged in the balance of that fund even when it is found that the contribution so made is not wholly required for actual expenditure on elementary education in any year.
