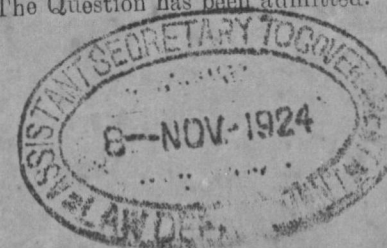

A.—(a) The proposal has not been abandoned.
