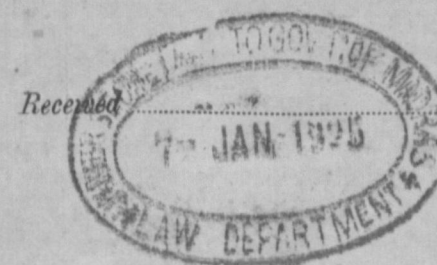

Copy of letter from the Principal, Law College, Madras, dated 3rd January 1925.

"I have the honour to submit herewith a copy of a note which the Advocate General circulated to the members of the Law College Council. The opinions of the other members are also typed under the note".

N o t e:

I understand that there have been communications in the newspapers pointing out the inconveniences of introducing the new scheme in the middle of an academic year. The students have

studied their subjects in part under the guidance of the existing Professors and Lecturers and new lecturers will not know what has been done and what remains to do. It is therefore suggested that the new scheme may conveniently be brought into force from July next, the commencement of the next academic year. It is for consideration whether it is not on the whole the more convenient course.

The present professors and lecturers will go out on the 1st of April. The budget of March 1924 has provided for them. The budget of March 1925 will provide for the expenses to be incurred under the new scheme. That the new scheme commences in July will mean a saving and no additional expense.

Moreover, there is the additional advantage that the persons appointed to be lecturers from July 1925 will have ample notice and ample time for preparation to enter upon their new duties.
