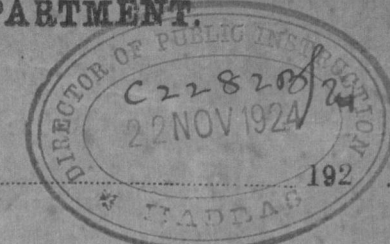

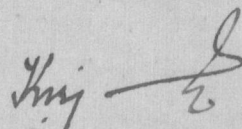
Compulsory Education has already been given effect to in this Municipality. A very large percentage of the children of the school going age belong to the poorer classes who have no means of livelihood. They find it very difficult to clothe their children and to

provide them with books and slates etc. The amount allotted by the Council will be judiciously utilized only in really deserving cases. No provision has been made in the Budget; but the expenditure will be met from the balance under Elementary Education Fund.

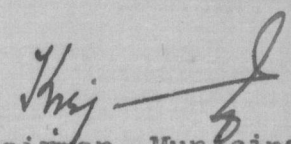

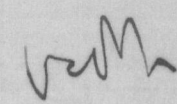

dated 14th November 1924 from the Chairman, Municipal
Council, Cochin referred to me for remarks in Government
endorsement No. 4250A-1 dated 21st November 1924, I have
