Tourist advertised in Messrs Addition & Co) instead of a double bullock cart.

I shall submit the voucher within a fortnight of receipt of orders.

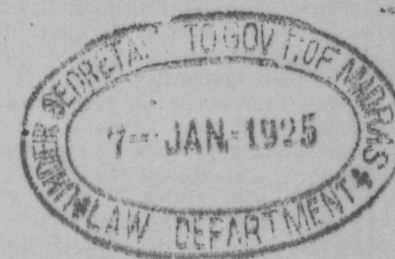
