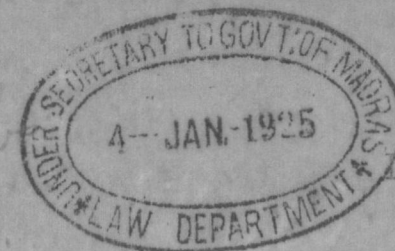

as Officiating Educational Commissioner
with the Government of India.

Sir,

I am directed to say that Mr. J. A. Richey, Educational Commissioner with the Government of India, has been granted leave on average pay for a period of eight months with effect from the 15th February 1925 and, subject to the concurrence of the Government of Madras, the Government of India desire to appoint Mr. R. Littlehailes, Director of Public Instruction, Madras Presidency, if he is agreeable, to officiate for Mr. Richey during his absence. I am accordingly to suggest that, if the local Government have no objection, the officiating appointment may be offered to Mr. Littlehailes.

2. The post of Educational Commissioner carries with it a pay of Rs 2,500-100-3,000 a month. The Educational Commissioner acts as Superintendent of Education, Delhi and Ajmer-Merwara, in addition to his own duties. He does not receive any extra remuneration on this account except a rent-free house at Delhi.

3. As the matter is one of urgency, the favour of an early reply is requested.

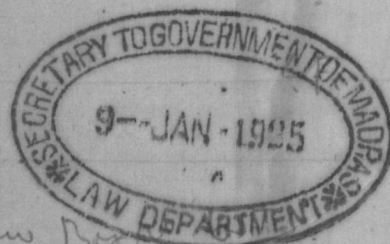
