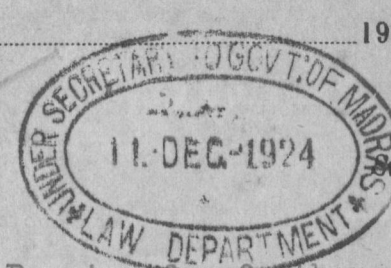

In G.O. No. 1855, Law (Education) dated 26-11-24,

it has been ordered that untrained persons who have passed the - third form of a recognised Secondary school might, when employed as teachers in aided elementary schools, be given the same treatment as trained teachers of the Lower Elementary Grade in assessing grant-in-aid.

It is requested that instructions may kindly be issued as to whether the same concession could be shown to -

- (i.) teachers who have passed the 8th standard of a 1st grade elementary school, (ii.) teachers who have failed in the T.S.L.C. examination of the Elementary Higher Grade, (iii.) teachers of the Elementary Higher Grade but whose certificates are

completed and (iv.) teachers who have passed the Lower Secondary examination or the old Middle school examination.

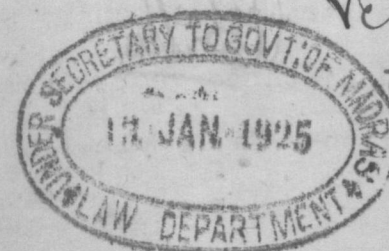

2. (i) Teachers who have passed the VIII Standard of a Higher Elementary School cannot be granted the concession given to teachers who have passed the III Form of a Secondary School, as the latter have in general a better education than the former.

(ii) Teachers who fail for the first time in the T.S.L.C. examination of Elementary Higher Grade and who are permitted to appear for the examination without being required to undergo further training may be treated as trained teachers of the Higher Grade for a period of

(iii) Teachers who have passed the T.S.L.C. examination of the Elementary Higher Grade but whose certificates are not completed can be treated as trained teachers of the Higher Grade only for a period of three years from the date of their passing the examination - Vide Rule 145 of the Madras Educational Rules.
